Dear Applicant,

The Newport News (VA) Chapter of the Links, Incorporated will award a \$2500 scholarship to a graduating high school female senior within our service areas of Newport News, Williamsburg-James City County, York County, and Gloucester, Virginia. The scholarship is available to a young lady who has demonstrated academic achievement and leadership in her school and community and will matriculate at either an accredited Historically Black College and University (HBCU) degree-granting four-year college or university or an accredited two-year college.

The recipient will receive the award over a two-year or four-year period at the payout discretion of the committee and must be a full-time student. The recipient must remain in good standing with the college or university and provide proof of enrollment to receive each monetary installment. Checks will be distributed annually upon receipt of enrollment documentation.

The Links, Incorporated was established in 1946 and has a current membership of over 17,000 professional women of color in 299 chapters located in the United States, including, the District of Columbia and the Commonwealth of the Bahamas. It is one of the nation's oldest and largest volunteer services organizations of extraordinary women who have documented over 1 million service hour annually, and are committed to enriching, sustaining, and ensuring the culture and economic survival of African Americans and other persons of African ancestry.

To apply for the Chapter's scholarship, the enclosed 2024 Scholarship Application Form must be completed and submitted by **April 3, 2024.** The application packet can also be found on the Chapter's website at <u>www.newportnewslinks.org</u>. Applications received after the deadline will not be considered.

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<u>Eligibility</u>: The applicant must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- 1. Must be a female high school senior graduating in 2024;
- 2. Must have a GPA of 2.5 or above on a 4.0 scale;
- 3. Must enroll in an accredited four-year Historically Black College and University (HBCU) or an accredited two-year college.

How to Apply: The following items must be submitted together.

- 1. A completed Newport News (VA) Chapter of The Links, Incorporated 2024 Scholarship Application; Preference is for it to be submitted electronically via QR Code on page one.
- 2. OFFICIAL high school transcript(s) to be emailed to kblinks2022@gmail.com;
- 3. An original one-page typed, double-spaced essay (*Please use a 12-point font, minimum of 500 words; not to exceed 750 words);*
- 4. Two letters of recommendation (see page 4 for electronic submission instructions). One letter must be submitted from a school official and the second letter may be submitted from a community representative.

Instructions:

- Type or print legibly on the application form. The application can also be retrieved from the Newport News Chapter of the Links Incorporated website at www.newportnewslinks.org;
- You may submit your application materials electronically (preferred) or you may mail it in to the address below;
- Submit all credentials (application, transcript and two letters of recommendation) in one packet or one PDF for online submission (no GoogleDoc submissions—only PDF);
- ONLY COMPLETED PACKAGES WILL BE REVIEWED;
- If mailed, the <u>completed</u> application (typed) packet must be postmarked by **April 3, 2024:**
